DEFINITIONS

- I § 1.15 **“Classified Employee”** means an employee who has successfully completed six consecutive months of employment in the classified service and is otherwise suitable for retention. (Added October 1, 2010)
- I § 1.93 **“Working Test Period”** means the time when an employee is considered to be in an on-the-job test situation for a period of six (6) consecutive months. (Added December 19, 2001) (Amended October 1, 2010)

- I § 1.15 **“Classified Employee”** means an probationary employee who has successfully completed ~~six consecutive months of employment in the classified service and is otherwise suitable for retention. (Added October 1, 2010)~~the working test period.
